Your NHS Wheelchair Service

Information for disabled people, relatives, carers and personal assistants

The service

AJM Healthcare is your wheelchair service. We aim to help you to be independently mobile in your home and your local community by providing a range of wheelchairs and cushions to suit your needs.

Who can use our service?

The wheelchair service is available to adults and children whose mobility is affected by long-term disability or a life limiting medical condition.

How to get your wheelchair

If you need a wheelchair, your GP or a health professional can refer you, or you can refer yourself for an assessment. We have available a wide range of manual wheelchairs, battery-powered electric wheelchairs and cushions. The time from referral to assessment will usually be less than 6 weeks and will depend on the urgency of your need.

If you meet the requirements set by the NHS, you may be able to get a FREE wheelchair on the NHS from us. Alternatively, if you fall outside the eligibility requirements, you can buy your wheelchair from us.

Buying your wheelchair

If you have a Personal Health Budget or other funds, you may wish to buy a wheelchair. The process for this is the same as if you were receiving an NHS wheelchair.

Your assessment

Our team of occupational therapists, physiotherapists and rehabilitation engineers are here to assess you. They will:

- find out how much you can do for yourself and where you need support
- ensure you can sit comfortably
- check your wheelchair fits your needs and is safe to use

You should receive your chair within 13 weeks of being assessed. When you have your wheelchair, we will be available to maintain and, if necessary, to repair it.

If your chair needs an emergency repair, you can phone us and we will come and repair it as soon as possible. This service is free.
